





Gas: Production Indicator 1972-2018




Europe's **PRODUCTION INDICATOR FOR GAS** is **46%** 

Europe is still able to meet nearly half of its consumption with domestic supply, in spite of a decline in production for the past decade

Europe's **PRODUCTION INDICATOR FOR OIL** is **23%** 


Europe is able to meet just under a quarter of its oil demand through indigenous production


